Wider Learning Week 2024 Year 9 Day-by-Day Reminders

Wider Learning Week (WLW) will run from Monday 8 - Friday 12 July 2024. Your son/ward will take part in a range of activities related to the pathway they selected earlier in the year. All activities are designed to promote wider understanding, independence, and challenge.

Key Points

- Canteen will be open as normal for on-site students.
- Full school uniform should be worn, and equipment brought as normal.
- Students are allowed to wear plain black trainers for any trips.
- Students taking part in **Sports Week** will need to wear their **PE/Games Kit** as instructed in the table
- Students should bring a packed lunch (FSM students will be provided with one), as well as a bottle of water and suncream needed for trips.
- Students will be meeting in different rooms each day - these will be displayed on screens around the school, so they need to check when they arrive each morning.
