Open Evening Arrangements

This year's annual Open Evening will be taking place from 5.45 - 8.00pm on **Wednesday 25 September**. Be aware that many students will be involved in either the evening displays or the tours that we put on for prospective students and parents/carers.

Early Close – 1.10pm, Wednesday 25 September

To allow students and the staff to go home and then return for the evening activities, the school will close at **1.10pm on Wednesday 25 September**. Students on Free School Meals will be able to obtain their meal at break or at 1.10pm from the canteen.

Late Start – 10.45am, Thursday 26 September
