1: taking care to do things carefully and correctly

conscientious

Used in a sentence:

- *He/she was a conscientious student/teacher/worker*
- *He was thorough and conscientious, rather than brilliant.*
- *He had a conscientious approach to revision.*

Etymology and historical meaning of the term **conscientious** :

From the early 17th century, French word *consciencieux*.
Originating from medieval Latin *conscientiosus*, meaning 'being privy to'.
The word comes from the from the verb *conscire*.
con means 'with' + *scire* means 'know'.
