•He had a conscientious approach to revision.

#### **<u>Etymology</u>** and historical meaning of the term conscientious :

From the early 17th century, French word *consciencieux*. Originating from medieval Latin *conscientiosus*, meaning 'being privy to'. The word comes from the from the verb *conscire*. *con means* 'with' + *scire means* 'know'.
