Christmas Charity Drive 2024 - Food Collection and Christmas Jumper Day

We are launching our next charity appeals of the academic year.

Food Collection (Monday 9 – Friday 13 December)

This appeal aims to collect donations, in the form of food and other products, from the school community to help support a local project called 'The Community Food Pantry' at the Bridgelink. This aims to provide support for those in need within the local community.

The whole school community will be encouraged to make donations. Students will be asked to collect food, cleaning products and toiletries. A list of specific items below are products that the project is asking for:

- Cereal and porridge (Oats)
- Baked beans and tinned tomatoes
- Tinned beans (Kidney, lentils, broad etc) and chickpeas
- Tinned fruit and vegetables
- Tinned cooked meals such as spaghetti, soups, etc
- Tinned tuna/fish/ meat
- Rice, pasta and sauces
- Tea, coffee and sugar
- Squash/ juice concentrate
- Jam and biscuits
- Cleaning products such as multipurpose cleaners, bathroom cleaners, surface sprays
- Toilet paper
- Laundry detergent and handwash
- Toiletries such as toothpaste, soap, shower gel, shampoo etc.
- Nappies and baby wipes

Christmas Jumper Day – Thursday 12 December

Every year, students are invited to wear a Christmas jumper and donate to Save the Children, a UK charity that works in over 100 countries to make sure children are fed, learning, and treated fairly.
