## Etymology and historical meaning of the term **regeneration**

The word "regeneration" comes from the Latin verb "regenerāte," meaning "to bring forth again." The prefix "re-" means "again," and "generation" refers to "the act of producing or bringing into existence"

**Collocations:** cell regeneration, urban regeneration, nerve regeneration, economic regeneration, regeneration process, regeneration project.
